North latitude 22° is such a scale of magic that world-famous coastal tourism destinations and resorts majorly locate here. Located on the southern side of the Tropic of Cancer, where mornings are pleasantly awakened by gentle light and nights conclude peacefully with the symphony of the waves.

Hengqin is also located at north latitude 22° , with a total area of about 106 square kilometres, facing Coloane Island and Taipa Island in Macao across the sea. Located on the west bank of the Pearl River estuary, it is adjacent to Hong Kong, Macao, and South China Sea. Moreover, Hengqin and the west district of Zhuhai are neighbours separated only by a strip of water. The favourable ecological environment and natural resources have become one of the well-known identity symbols of Hengqin. Following Hainan and Pingtan in Fujian province, Hengqin ranks the third international leisure tourism island at home. Hengqin's coastline contains all five elements favoured by international tourists: sunshine, sea, beach, greenery and fresh air.

Travel lovers who fancy excitement will be astonished by the world's largest aquarium, Asia's largest unpowered amusement park, and a 360-degree VR panoramic roller coaster in Hengqin. Nature lovers who wish to be in close proximity to the nature will be attracted by a 392-hectares wetland, a flower promenade that is approximately 14 kilometres long, and "China's most beautiful bicycle lane" of 40 kilometres around the island. Art enthusiasts who show deep interest in arts are welcomed to appreciate imperial exhibits from Qianlong Period, five intangible cultural heritage - architectural manifestation of traditional craftsmanship and the "Roman Forum" . It is worth mentioning that the fastest clearance via Hengqin port to Macao only requires 10 seconds, and more one-stop facilities for convenient travel, shopping, entertainment, food, accommodation, and transportation await you in Hengqin.

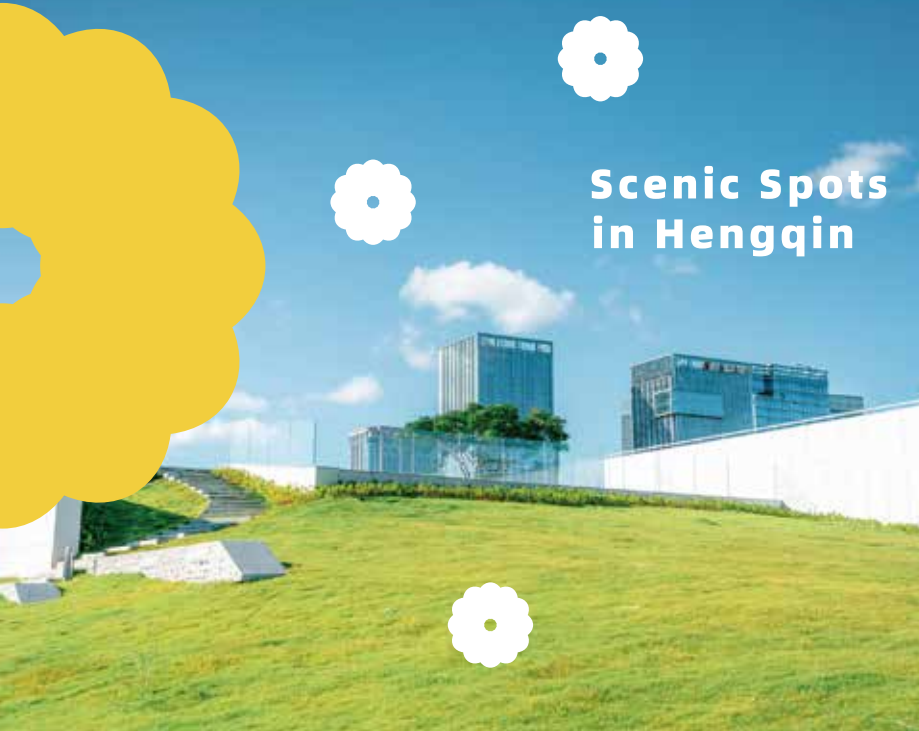

Flower Promenade in Hengqin

The Flower Promenade in Hengqin covers a full length of about 14 kilometres with a beautiful view of flower sea. Depending on the flowering season, there are cherry blossom kapok tree, flamboyant, Kapok, etc. The long corridor stretches across three cross-sea bridges and the Mangzhou Wetland Park. Besides flower appreciation, camping and picnics are also welcome here.



Mangzhou Wetland Park

The Mangzhou Wetland Park, which is shaped like a peninsula, has six functional zones: Ecological Promotion and Exhibition Zone, Wetland Ecological Conservation Zone, Wetland Ecological Exhibition Zone, Wetland Leisure Experience Zone, Coastline Ecological Plant Appreciation Zone, and Management Service Zone. Moreover, modern architecture such as a three-layered viewing platform and a zig-zag lotus bridge can also be found in the Park. The Mangzhou Wetland Park is an ideal location for leisurely exercise where visitors may experience peace and tranquillity.

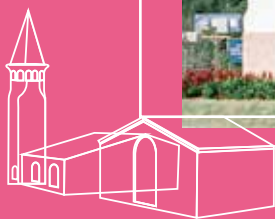

Tianmu River Rowing Park

Transportation: Take Bus No. Z50 to Wenbo Intersection Station, then walk about 300m to get here

With an area of 72,000 square metres, the rowing park has a splendid sunset view. The park is awash with a “watery” theme, with walkways intersecting and crisscrossing like waves of water. Trees and plants are diversely distributed in the park, portraying a variety of colours throughout the four seasons. Besides, the park owns an exclusive wetland where abundant water-growing plants are cultivated. While wandering through the park, you can experience the glamour of rowing and enjoy the nature breeze. In addition, a Chinese-style afternoon tea or camping by the water are some enjoyable ways to amuse oneself.

Legend Ponto Square

Legend Ponto Square is located opposite the Hengqin port, where it is surrounded by modern skyscrapers and high-rise residences.

The square is designed by Carlos Marreiros, mixing Chinese elements into the Manueline architectural style. The square has become a travel hit and a new choice for wedding photo shoots.

Chimelong Ocean Kingdom- Chimelong Spaceship

Located in Hengqin, Zhuhai Chimelong Ocean Kingdom is one of the world's largest ocean theme parks. The theme park, which is divided into eight themes, features displays of rare marine animals and amusement facilities, as well as three large theatres. Tourists may also indulge in worldwide delicacies and go shopping here.

The Chimelong Spaceship is about 650 metres long and has a total gross floor area of about 400,000 square metres. It is a large-scale indoor theme park that integrates distinctive and diverse ecological landscapes, rare marine animals exhibitions, educational initiatives, imitation of space, immersive and interactive performances, high-tech amusement facilities, special dining and themed merchandise offerings.

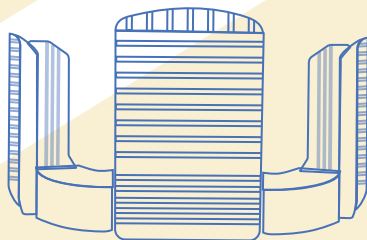

Novotown



Hengqin branch, China Red Sandalwood Museum

Located in the centre of Hengqin, the Hengqin Branch is the first branch of the China Red Sandalwood Museum to be established outside the capital. With an overall construction area of more than 12,000 square metres, the branch is a typical imitation of classical buildings of the Ming and Qing dynasties with a magnificent appearance. Inside the museum, it is mainly composed of central hall, exhibit hall, VIP hall, multifunctional hall. These halls integrate art exhibition, culture exchange, and creative experience.

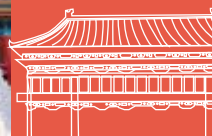

Stone Park

Situated on the north coast of Hengqin, the Stone Park is a distinctive and fascinating theme park dedicated to stone culture . The park is a great spot to visit and relax during the holidays since it is full of hills and mountains, picturesque peaks and rocks, and lush greenery that are quaint and intriguing at the same time. It is also readily accessible from north to south.

Stone Park adopts stone culture as its theme and incorporates tourism, leisure, and stone appreciation into its scope. The park's planning and design fully capture the connotations of Chinese stone culture. The relationship between stone and other phenomena is comprehensively depicted via landscape language and the efforts of the staff, including the content of “stone and earth” , “stone and human life” , “stone and love” , “stone and art” , “stone and music” and “stone and folk custom” . The Stone Park offers visitors a novel perspective and interpretation of stone.

The Portuguese stone carving in Hongqi Village was carved in June 1937 (the ROC 26). It was recorded that in 1887, the 13th year of the reign of Emperor Guangxu of the Qing Dynasty, the Portuguese arrived at Hengqin Island. Separated from Macao by a body of water, Hengqin Island has developed into a location for Macao residents to gather water as a result of the scarcity of fresh water in Macao. The Japanese occupied Hengqin in 1938 (the ROC 27) and withdrew in 1945 (the ROC 34). Later, the Portuguese repaired the reservoir and the stone carving and regained water resources for Zhuhai and Macao residents. The Portuguese stone carving is the first historical relic found on Hengqin Island that is directly related to Portugal and Macao.

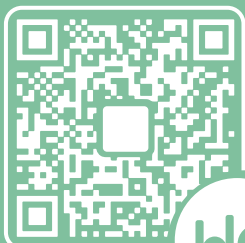
Postscript
